

On the matter of the
 Petition of A. J. Parnell
 for location of Road

On the 11th day of April A.D. 1880, a petition was filed signed by A. J. Parnell and 20 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a road as follows.

Beginning at a point in the north line of the A.B. & Co. Sec. 28, 2, 13, R. 19, near the foot of the bluff where the old Township road intersects said north line thence south or south west along the most practical route 80 rods to the north line of the South Half of said A.B. & Co. Sec. 28, 2, 13, R. 19, thence west on or near said line to the west line of said Sec. 28, 2, 13, R. 19, also from the commencement of last mentioned section of road at terminus of first mentioned road deflecting north east when practicable to the north line of Sec. 27, 12, 19, East to the terminus of said road at the corner of the A.B. & Co. Sec. 27, 12, 19.

Also the following which is made a part of the above Petition.

That the road through sections 21 and 22, 2, 13, R. 19, the old Township road is our main road and as no work has been done on said road on account of the locality of said road not being determined and as it is a question and the only way to establish the same seems to be a review. We respectfully ask that you appoint a review on said road.

Said petition was accompanied by bond as required by law, signed by A. J. Parnell William Hester H. M. Bowen in the sum of all costs and expenses which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that, W. L. Kennedy, Andrew Douglass and W. Marshall be appointed viewers of said roads and upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and locate and re-locate the roads according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their action to this Board.
