

In the matter of the
Petition of James S. Dunn
for location of Road

On the 4th day of April A.D. 1885, a petition was filed signed by James S. Dunn and 19 others and presented to the Board of County Comm. praying for the location of a road as follows.

Beginning at N.W. Corner Sec. 20, T. 13, R. 14, thence South on section line or as near as practicable for the distance of one and a half miles to East and West road through center of sections 29 and 30.

Said petition was accompanied by Bond as required by law, signed by James S. Dunn as principal and Peter Dunn & Lewis Stewart as sureties, in the sum of all costs & expenses, which bond was approved and it appearing to the board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that J. M. Stewart, J. A. Capping & W. M. Davis be appointed viewers of said road and upon the day named in their notice together with the County Clerks they proceed to view and locate said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Board adjourned to meet April 15, 1885 at 9 o'clock.
