

Lawrence Shaw. April 15. 1885.

Board of County Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to adjournment at the Office of the County Clerk.

There were present Com.

John Miller Chairman. Mr. Draper and J. Hall Co., and County Clerk J. S. White.

The Board had under consideration the M. J. Cunningham Road and after giving to parties in favor of and against the Road a hearing it was passed to July session 1885.

Markley Road granted }
except the north half mile }

On the 9th day of April 1885. a Road petition signed by Jacob Markley and 41 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for a road as follows.

Beginning at the terminus of the public road running due north from the Millers Springs Post Office, on the South East corner of the North East quarter of Section 9. Township 14. R. 19. Thence running North 160 rods to the South East corner of Sec. 4. T. 14. R. 19. Thence running West 160 rods to the South East corner of the South East quarter Sec. 4 T. 14. Range 19. Thence running North one mile on the half section line to the North East corner of the North East 1/4 of Sec. 4. T. 14. R. 19. to intersect the public road.

The Board having under consideration the proposed road and no objection having been made against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility. It was ordered that said road be declared located and established except the north half mile thereof, and that full record thereof be made in the Road Record.

D. Gady was appointed Constable of McKamee Township and declined who refused to qualify.

Resignation of Dr. L. Standley, Constable of Marion Township was accepted.

Report of Shuster of Palmyra Shop. for the year 1884-5. Examined & approved.
