In the Matter of the
Vacation of Road on
Petition of W. R. McCarty

On January 19, 1885, a petition signed by W. R. McCarty and 17 others asking for the vacation of a road described as follows:
Beginning at the N.W. Corner of Sec. 1st, T. 12, R. 18. Thence East on Section line about 80 Rods. Thence South about 160 rods all in Decatur County.
The Board having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against it. It was ordered that the survey report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared vacated in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Survey of Decatur County Township be satisfied to cause the same to be closed.

Board had under consideration claims against the County.

Board adjourned to meet Sept. 17, 1886, at 9 o'clock a.m.
