

Lawrence April 17, 1885.

Board met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk. Those were present Commissioners John Dalton Chairman, Wm. Draper and J. E. McCoy and County Clerk Joel S. White.

In the matter of payment of
Interest Coupons on Bonds.
Compromised

S. M. E. Griffith presented Coupons for payment as follows. Coupon #61 for 35⁰⁰ due July 1, 1877, issued on Bond No. 61 to St. L. & S. O. R. R. Co. which was ordered paid on same basis of Settlement as other Bonds and Coupons of June 15, 1880. to wit: at 50% of amt. of Prin. & interest. Thus 200.00 x .50 = 100.00 + 35⁰⁰ = 135.00
Coupon No. 127 due July 1, 1877, issued on Bond No. 127 to Pleasant Hill R.R. Co. which was ordered paid on same basis of Settlement as other Bonds and Coupons of Sept. 24, 1880. to wit: at 90 cents on the dollar of amount of principal and interest. Thus 500.00 x .90 = 450.00 + 100.00 = 550.00
Total paid for both Coupons \$685.00

It was further ordered that the County Clerk be directed to draw check in favor of S. M. E. Griffith in payment of same.

In the Matter of the Petition
of J. B. Ward & others for
location of road

The Board having under consideration the proposed road and no legal objections having been offered against it. It was ordered that the views report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said Road be declared located and established in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Survey of Accommodation Road be notified to cause the same to be opened to Public Travel.
