

In the matter of the Petition

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility. It was ordered that the survey report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Justice of Millaw Spring Township be notified to cause the same to be opened to public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to draw an order on the County Treasurer in favor of Thomas McQuinnan for Amely dollars (\$90.⁰⁰) in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location of said Road.
