

In the Matter of the Petition of }
J. D. Steele for the location of road }

On the 21st day of April 1885, a road petition was filed signed by J. D. Steele and 18 others and presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the re-location of a road described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Center line of Section No. 16 Township No. 13, Range 18 in Clinton Township, Douglas County Kansas running East and West, where the present State road No. 196 angles through the South East quarter of said Section No. 16, upon the most practical route for a road to intersection of the East line of said Section No. 16, aforesaid.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by J. D. Steele as principal and J. C. Moore & C. J. Woodward as sureties in the sum of all costs and expenses accruing on the view, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that J. C. Stevens, J. C. Mutton, and J. M. Shepherd be appointed viewers of said road and upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view layout and re-locate said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Beginning at the North East Corner of the North West quarter of Sec. No. 19, T. 13, R. 18, E. in Douglas County Kansas and angling through said Sec. No. 19. Said Road No. 1st located in 1865. through said 1/4 section is impractical for a road and is not needed for a public highway.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by J. D. Steele as principal and J. C. Moore and C. J. Woodward as sureties, in the sum of all costs and expenses accruing on the view, which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that Saml. Rabon, Geo. Ratter and H. E. Green be appointed viewers of said road and upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and vacate said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
