

Shawnee 10. April 26. 1885.

In the Matter of the Petition of
Chas. M. Dubois for the
Dedication of road

On the 1st day of January 1885 a road petition was filed signed by Chas. M. Dubois and others asking for survey of road described as follows.

"Beginning at a point about 70 rods east of the N.E. Cor. of the S.W. 1/4 Sec. 7, 14, 19. Thence in a south easterly direction on the most practicable route to intersect said road at 175 at a point about 20 rods north of the South West corner of the S.W. 1/4 Sec. 7, 14, 19." Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law.

It was ordered that the report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road as dedicated be declared located and established in accordance therewith - full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustees of Millers Spring be notified to cause the same to be opened to public travel.

In the Matter of the Petition of
J. D. Nod & others for
Location of road

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the Establishment of the same and deeming it to be of public utility. It was ordered that the review report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record. Shawnee County be notified of this action and the Trustees of Desomption Township be notified to cause the same to be opened to public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to draw orders on the County Treas. in favor of Anthony Leif for \$50.00 and J. D. Nod for \$12.00 in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location of said road - so far as the County of Douglas is liable. Shawnee County duly notified.
