The Board entered into agreement with the City of Lawrence
for use of room heretofore occupied by the Police Judges, being the rooms adjoining
the office now occupied by the Register of Deeds the "Municipal Rooms" or City Hall
situated on the north west corner of Monument and Henry Streets in the City of Lawrence
for the use of the County Superintendent and County Surveyor for the term
of four years and eight months at an annual rental of one hundred
dollars per year from April 1, 1885. Eight months rent prepaid in advance
(\$66.⁶⁶) balance payable quarterly in sums of 25⁰⁰ each. (See laws on file)
