Palmyra Township }

The Board having the official assessors returns of assessments of Palmyra Twp. under consideration and it appearing that the items of Cattle, Corn, wheat and Oats are assessed below the basis agreed upon by the General Township assessors at their meeting March 2. 1885. It was ordered that ten per cent be added to the assessed value of Cattle.

The following resolution was offered. That fifty per cent be added to the assessed value of wheat, Corn and Oats in Palmyra Twp. for the year 1885.

The yeas and nays being called for. The gentlemen voted as follows. John Walton, no. Wm. Draper, no. J. E. McCoy, yes.

A motion to add 50% to assessed value of wheat was carried. But afterwards reconsidered and upon a vote being taken on the original resolution all the gentlemen voted no.
