The Board of County Commissioners met in special session at the office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioners John Hutton Chairman, H. Draper and J. E. McCoy, and County Clerk Joel S. White.

Electing Health Officer }

The Board had under consideration the election of a Health Officer in compliance with the Law passed March 17, 1855, creating the Masses Board of Health.

On motion a ballot was had which resulted as follows.

1st ballot. Dr. Martin. Dudson City 1 vote.

Dr. P. D. Dore. Lancaster 1 "

Dr. St. Simmons " 1 "

2nd ballot. Dr. P. D. Dore " 1 vote

Dr. St. Simmons " 2 votes.

Dr. St. Simmons having received a majority of all the votes cast was declared Elected Health Officer. On motion of H. Draper the vote was made unanimous.
