On motion a ballot was had which resulted as follows:

2nd ballot. D^r. P. D. Morse " 1 vote

D^r A. Stevens " 2 votes.

D^r A. Stevens having received a majority of all the votes cast
was declared Elected Health Officer. Resolution of the Draper therefore
was made unanimous.
