Dedication of Road by
Daniel Ulrich & others

The Board having under consideration the Dedication of a certain road described in petition as follows:

"Beginning at a point on road No. 175, about two rods north of the S.E. Corner of Section 1, T. 24. R. 18, running thence in a southeasterly direction about 90 rods. Thence South to the South line of the S.E. 1/4 Sec 12, T. 24. R. 18. Thence East on said line about thirty five rods to intersect with road No. 175." and no legal objections having been made against the establishment of the same and deeming it to be of public utility it was ordered that the report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be located and established in accordance therewith, full record thereof be made in the County Road Record and the Trustees of Melrose Springs Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County Scrip in favor of Isaac Studebaker, John Studebaker & Daniel Truchette for forty six dollars (\$46.00) to be by them divided among themselves pro rata as their interest may appear. in full Compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said Dedicated road.

Proposition of

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition it was ordered that the County Board be authorized to permit C. B. Warner to secure the County's interest in lots Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 & 14 in Block 21 Prairie City for fifty Cents, each per lot without cost of redemption.
