

Lawrence Kans. Aug. 22. 1885.

Board of County Commissioners met in special session at the office of the County Clerk: But said special Commissioners John Patton Chairman H. Draper and J. E. McCoy and County Clerk J. A. White

In the matter of
Settlement of Claims in
favor of the City of Lawrence

Thos. Pachler, Mayor and J. A. Roberts Commissioners on the part of the City of Lawrence came before the Board and agreed upon the following, in full settlement of all claims and demands against the County.

Whereas: a controversy and dispute having arisen between the City of Lawrence and the County of Douglas, Kansas as to the amount of money due to the said City of Lawrence from said County of Douglas on account of taxes collected by said County of Douglas and on account of various other matters dealings and transactions between said City and said County.

Now for the purpose of fully, finally and forever settling and satisfying all claims of said City of Lawrence for taxes collected by said County of Douglas and all accounts, claims, demands and causes of action, which have accrued or may hereafter accrue to said City of Lawrence or to said County of Douglas by reason of said dealings, matters and transactions aforesaid: it is hereby agreed by and between said City of Lawrence and County of Douglas, Kansas as follows:

The said County of Douglas agrees to pay to said City of Lawrence the sum of Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) payable as follows:

Twenty five hundred dollars (\$2,500) on the first day of December A.D. 1885; and Twenty five hundred dollars (\$2,500) on the first day of June A.D. 1886.

And the said City of Lawrence agrees to and does hereby accept said sum of Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) payable in the manner aforesaid in full settlement, satisfaction, release and discharge of all claims of said City for taxes collected by said County, all accounts, claims or demands and causes of action which have accrued or may hereafter accrue to said City against said County by reason of any transactions, dealings or matters between said City and County, of whatever kind or character including what is known as the "small pox bill".

It is hereby fully agreed and understood, by and between the said City of Lawrence and County of Douglas that this settlement shall be and the same is hereby final and conclusive as to all matters and things as aforesaid between said City of Lawrence and County of Douglas up to the time of the commencement of Paul R. Benson's term of Office as County Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, also including the said small pox bill, to wit the tenth day of October 1882.
