

Lawrence Kansas Oct. 7, 1885.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the Office of the County Clerk. Those were present Commissioners John Wallen Chairman, W. Draper and J. Eldredge and County Clerk J. S. White.

Appropriations to
Build Certain Bridges and
to pay City of Lawrence
Settlement Contract

The Board ordered that a sum not to exceed the following amounts to pay for building the following bridges, to be paid out of the County general fund.

Captains Creek Bridge \$1000⁰⁰
Rock Creek " " " " \$2000⁰⁰
" " " " " " \$2000⁰⁰
Washington " " " " \$2000⁰⁰

It was further ordered that the Chairman of the Board and County Clerk be authorized to draw warrant on the County Treasurer in payment when the bridges are completed and accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

It was further ordered that the Chairman of the Board and County Clerk be authorized to draw warrants on the County Treasurer in favor of the City of Lawrence in payment of Contract of August 22, 1885.

Board had under consideration claims against the County and Bridge and Road matters.

Adjourned to meet Oct. 8, 1885. at 9 o'clock.
