

Lawrence Harris. Oct. 10, 1885.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners John Mutton Chairman
McKeefer and Jno. E. McCoy, and County Clerk J. S. White.

for location of Road }

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been made against the establishment of said road and believing the same to be of public utility, it was ordered: that the Miners' report of view and report and plat of survey of June 1884 be adopted, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat as Road No. 427 and the Trustees of Matamoras Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.

It is further ordered: that the County Clerk issue a warrant payable to Robert Hattie for fifty dollars in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location of said road, to wit: (the following are the damages of the old road surveyed by order of Board)

Begin at the sec. line of Sec. 28 T. 13. R. 19, 40 R. West of N.E. Cor. of said Sec. 28. Thence S. 65° E. to a point 70 R. S. of the said N.E. Cor. or Sec. 28. Thence S. 50° E. to a point 100 R. S. of the N.E. Cor. of T. 13. R. 19, Thence S. to said N.E. Cor. of T. 13. R. 19, Sec. 22.

Thence E. 4 miles. Thence north and west.

Final notes of road as hereby located.

Beginning 11.25 ch East of the N.E. Cor. of Sec. 28 T. 13. R. 19, (May 11.9° 40' E),
