In the Matter of the
Petition of F. Deichman and
others for Location & Vacation of Road }

On the 9th day of October 1885, a road petition signed by F. Deichman and 17th others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas praying for the location and vacation of Roads described as follows.

Beginning at the North West Corner of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 10, T.13, R.20. (Thence due East to the North East Corner of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 11, T.13, R.20. thence due South 80 R. to the South East Corner of the North $\frac{1}{4}$ of said $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 11.)

And Vacate. That portion of the road heretofore established diagonally through the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10, T.13, R.20.

Also Vacate. That portion of the road heretofore established beginning at the North West Corner of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 11, T.13, R.20. running thence South 80 Rods. thence East 160 rods more or less to the S. E. Corner of the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 11, T.13, R.20.

Said petition was accompanied with bond, as required by law, signed by R. C. Johnston, ^{as principal} J. C. Burnham & J. M. Johnston, as sureties in the penal sum of all costs and expenses.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that Geo. Bonner, Elias Baldwin & J. St. Harrison be appointed Viewers of this proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the place of beginning, on the day named in their notice and proceed to view and lay out and to vacate said Road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
