Resolution in regard
to Co. line Bridge

The Commissioners of Johnson County having refused to sign Contract for building Bridge across Captains Creek on the County line between Douglas and Johnson Counties, claiming that under the law they would not be liable for ^{more} than a proportionate amount based on the assessment of A.D. 1885.

The following resolution was unanimously adopted and the County Clerk directed to forward a certified copy to the Commissioners of Johnson Co.

Resolved: That in the matter of building a bridge over Captains Creek on the line between Johnson and Douglas Counties Kansas that as the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County having appropriated Six thousand dollars for said bridge, said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kans. hereby agree with and promise the Board of County Commissioners of Johnson County Kans. that they will adjust and pay at their meeting in January, 1886 whatever balance may be due from the County of Douglas based upon the total tax levied for the year 1885 in said Counties in accordance with the law.
