The Board of County Commissioners met in Special Session at the Office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioners John D. Bates, Chairman, Mr. Draper and John C. McCoy, and County Clerk Joel S. White.

Ordered,

That J. C. McCoy be authorized to confer with the City Council and make a proposition, that if the City will erect a flag pole on the City building, that the County will furnish a flag for the same.

Ordered,

That in consequence of the increased amount of work in the County Clerk's Office, growing out of the changes made by law, when a County has over 25000 inhabitants. It was ordered that the Salary of W. D. Greene, Deputy County Clerk be increased 200\$, making his salary \$1000. ~~per annum~~ from Dec. 1, 1885.
