The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment
at the Office of the County Clerk

Then were present John Matton Chairman, Draper
and J. E. McCoy, Commissioners and J. S. White County Clerk.

In the Matter of the
petition of H. H. Armstrong &
others for the location of a road }

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid
road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of
the same and deeming it to be of public utility. It was ordered that
said road be located from the center of Sec. 17. to the East line thereof
or to the end of road as petitioned for Oct. 5. 1885. And the Trustee of said
area be notified to cause the same to be opened to the public road.
It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to draw an
order on the County Treasurer in favor of John Sexton for thirty
five dollars in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the
location and establishment of said road, # 414
