

Jan 7. 1886

In the Matter of Road
petitioned for by Geo. M. Markley
and Co others

On the 4th day of January 1886 a road petition signed by George M. Markley and 30 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kans. praying for the location of a certain road described as follows.

Beginning at the Center of Sec. 11, T. 11, R. 19. Thence North one half section line to the intersection of the Township line road, between Willow Springs and Wakarusa Townships.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Geo. M. Markley as principal and Jacob Markley as surety in the penal sum of all costs and expenses.

Whereupon said Board was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that A. P. Ramsey, W. A. Pardee and M. A. Marshall be appointed viewers of the proposed road and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day named in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

Board adjourned to meet Jan 8, 1886 at 9 o'clock am.
