The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the Office of the County Clerk

Here were present Commissioners Wm Draper Chairman  
John Walter and J. E. McCoy and County Clerk J. White

In the Matter of the petition of

the location & location of Road

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the Surveyor report and draw and report and plat of Survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and established <sup>and location made</sup> in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustees of Neodesha & Eudora Townships be notified to cause the same to be open for public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County Deeds in favor of John Edemas for \$15<sup>00</sup> and R. C. Johnson for \$10<sup>00</sup> in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road. #429.

In the Matter of the  
location of certain road or  
the petition of J. D. Steele & others

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the location of the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against said location and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the Surveyor report and draw and report and plat of Survey be adopted and said road be declared located in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustees of Leavenworth Township be notified to cause the same to be located.
