The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the Office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioners Mr. Draper Chairman John Wallen and J. E. McCoy and County Clerk J. S. White.

In the Matter of the petition of
J. Reichman and others for
the location & vacation of Road

The Board of County Commrs. Having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the Viewers Report and View and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located and established ^{and vacation made} in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustees of Naticket & Esleria Townships be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue County scrip in favor of John Elenas for \$100 and R. C. Johnson for \$100 in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road. #429.

In the Matter of the
Vacation of certain road in
the petition of J. S. Steele & others

The Board of County Commrs. Having under consideration the vacation of the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against said vacation and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the Viewers Report and View and report and plat of survey be adopted and said road be declared ~~vacated~~ ^{vacated} in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Trustees of Clinton Township be notified to cause the same to be vacated.
