In the Matter of the
Road petitioned for by
Mr. Sutton & 26 others }

On the 11th day of January at 1886 a road petition signed by Mr. Sutton and 26 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kans. praying for the location and location of a certain road described as follows.

"Locate. Beginning at foot of hill in old road in S. 11. 1/4. Sec. 13. 18. Thence to a point on S. line of said 1/4 sec. 50 rods west of S. & E. Cor. Thence S. as near as practicable to south bank of rock creek. Thence down said creek to bridge on old road. And locate, old road between beginning and ending of road asked for. Also. Begin near S. 11. 1/4. Sec. 33. 13. 18. Thence E. as near as practicable to old road or near road asked for above. Also begin at a point at foot of hill in road about 100 rods S. of the S. & E. Cor. of Sec. 33. 13. 18. Thence in a South westerly direction as near as practicable around said hill to the extreme West terminus thereof, thence by the most practicable route to South line of Sec. 33. 13. 18. Thence E. to Cor. of Sec. 33. & 34. 13. 18 and locate old road between points of beginning and ending of said road last above asked for. Also begin at the most practicable point on last road asked for in S. 1/4 of Sec. 33. 13. 18. Thence in a westerly direction to a point 50 rods E. of the N. line of the S. 1/4 of said Sec. 33. 13. 18. Thence S. to foot of hill. Thence in a South westerly direction as near foot of said hill as practicable to a ford on Rock Creek near the S. 1/4. Cor. of said 1/4 sec. Thence South westerly to the S. line of said Sec. 33. Thence N. on or near S. line to S. & E. Cor. of the S. 1/4 of Sec. 5. 14. 18. Thence S. in a South westerly direction to S. line of said 1/4 sec. Thence N. on or near half sec. line to the N. line of Sec. 6. 14. 18. to intersect Lawrence & Simpson's State Road. And to locate County road laid on South line of S. 1/4 Sec. 32. 12. 18."

Said petition was accompanied by bond as required by law, signed by Mr. Sutton as principal and J. M. Christian and James Marks as sureties in the penal sum of all costs & expenses.

Whereupon said Board was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the board, that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that D. C. Halbert, S. M. Reynolds and Eileen Elias be appointed viewers of the proposed road and that on the day named in their notice, they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law - giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

Board adjourned to meet Jan 13, 1886 at 9 o'clock
