The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session

Chas Lathrop, Director of Eudora Prop. reported the condition of the bridge on the State road 3 miles west of Captain Grant bridge and estimated the cost to repair the same at \$500⁰⁰. Mr. Lathrop made a verbal proposition that if the County would pay \$250⁰⁰ the Township would pay the balance. On motion it was ordered that an appropriation be made of \$250⁰⁰ to apply on material and work on said bridge, which is a County bridge the same to be paid when the work is done and accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

The Board continued the examination of claims against the County.

Board adjourned to meet tomorrow morning April 14. 1886.
