

Laurens News. April 15. AD 1886.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment.

Those were present Commissioners H. Draper Chairman. John Wallin and J. E. McCoy and County Clerk J. S. White.

Final order in the
matter of the Road petitioned
for by J. E. McCoy & others

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the views report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said Road be declared located and established in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Justice of Clinton Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue scrip to J. E. McCoy for twenty five dollars (\$25.00) S. O. Thacher twenty five dollars (\$25.00) R. A. Stute twenty five dollars (\$25.00) and Carson Hicks ap. for twelve or two dollars (\$12.00). in full compensation for all damage occasioned by the location and establishment of said Road.

Board continued the examination of claims against the County.

Board adjourned to meet April 16 at 9.06 A.M.
