Proposition of  
C. D. Stephens to  
redeem land }

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition it was ordered that the County Treasurer permit C. D. Stephens to redeem from sales of May 1866. Certain lands described in Certificate number 47, 65 and 66, for amount of original sale & cost of redemption.

Proposition of  
Hugh Blair to  
redeem land }

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid proposition it was ordered that the County Treasurer be permitted to allow Hugh Blair agt for the owner to redeem from tax 1865. Sale 1866. off # 172. the S/2 of the S/4. 10, 14, 18, for amount of original sale and cost of redemption.

Final order in the matter of the  
Road petitioned for by J. B. Baughman & others }

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the location & vacation of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the Reviewer report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be declared located & noted in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Committee of Ways & Means be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.

It was further ordered, that the County Clerk be instructed to issue scrip to Chas. Beanie and Mrs. Beanie for twenty & 5/100 dollars each in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location & vacation of said Road. 231
