Appropriation to pay  
Contracts for Bridges

The Board ordered that an appropriation be made to pay the Missouri Valley Bridge & Iron Works for the following Bridges contracted for, viz: The Anderson Crossing Bridge, The Washington Creek Bridge and the Bridge across Captains Creek, in County line between Douglas & Johnson Counties. Total for all Five Thousand dollars. \$5000

It was further ordered that the County Clerk and Chairmen of the Ward draw orders on the County Treasurer in payment of the same, when said Bridges are completed and accepted by the Board.

Final order on a part  
of the No. Sutton Road

The Board having under consideration the proposed Road and no legal objections having been offered against the location and establishment of that part hereinafter mentioned, and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the survey report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows.

Begin 12<sup>th</sup> Chains west of the corner between sec. 27 and 34. S. 13. R. 18. Thence east along north line of sec. 34, and South & Southeast to sec. 33. to S.E. Corner of sec. 33. Also begin at Oak tree 31<sup>st</sup> Chains north and 16<sup>th</sup> Chains east of S.E. Corner of sec. 33. Thence to Stone 24<sup>th</sup> Ch. north and 27<sup>th</sup> Ch. east of S.E. Cor. of sec. 33. (Has fence line about 200 yds.)
