The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at the Office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment

There were present Commissioners Mr. Draper Chairman John Macdonald and J. E. Kirby, and County Clerk Jas. S. White

In the matter of a Road }

On the 15th day of April AD 1886. a road petition signed by C. A. Neurich and 22 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas praying for the location of a certain road described as follows.

Beginning at the North East Corner of the North West quarter of Section Eight (8) Township Twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19) thence in a westerly direction along or near the line of the State Road Survey to the South West Corner of the North West quarter of Section One (1) Township Twelve (12) Range Eighteen (18).

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by C. A. Neurich as principal and H. B. Rogers and A. J. Hamble as sureties in the penal sum of all costs and expenses.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that J. C. Moore, Jordan Neal and H. Miller be appointed viewers of the proposed road and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day named in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
