

The amount of aid intended to be hereby voted by said Palmyra Township to said Railroad Company, and the amount proposed to be subscribed to and taken in the Capital Stock of said Railroad by said Palmyra Township, and the amount hereby petitioned and asked for is the sum of thirty five thousand dollars.

The Bonds of said Palmyra Township to be issued under the authority herein, and to be of the denomination of one thousand dollars each; to run thirty years, (redeemable after ten years from ^{this} date, at the will of the Township, when any installment of interest falls due), to bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, the principal and interest to be payable at the fiscal agency for the State of Kansas in the City of New York.

The said Railroad, when and as so built, shall extend from Kansas City in the State of Missouri, by lease or otherwise, to a point in Johnson County, in the State of Kansas, East or northeast, from said Palmyra Township, and from said point in a westerly or southwesterly direction through said Palmyra Township.

The said Railroad to be of standard gauge, to be a first-class road, and is to be built and completed from the point in Johnson County aforesaid, in a westerly or southwesterly direction through said Palmyra Township, and have cars running thereon on or before one year from the date of the election herein prayed for, unless prevented by legal proceedings, with a suitable freight and passenger depot to be located within one half mile of the crossing of High and Eighth Streets, Baldwin City, said Township.

When and immediately after the subscription of stock and issuance of bonds have been voted and authorized to be made and issued as herein provided, and said proposition shall have been determined in the affirmative by a canvass of the votes cast at said election, then the Board of County Commissioners of said Douglas County shall make an order authorizing and directing the County Clerk of said County to make such subscription of stock in the name of and for the benefit of said Palmyra Township to the amount of thirty five thousand dollars to the Capital Stock of said Railroad Company, and the County Clerk of said County shall make such subscription of stock immediately thereafter.

When the said Railroad Company shall have built and completed its said line of Railroad from the point in Johnson County aforesaid, in a westerly ^{or southwesterly} direction and through said Palmyra Township, and the cars are running thereon and shall have constructed a suitable freight and passenger depot in said township as aforesaid, then the Board of County Commissioners of said Douglas County, for and on behalf of said Palmyra Township shall cause to be issued as the law directs the Bonds of said Palmyra Township of the denomination and on the terms and conditions hereinbefore stated and described to the amount of thirty five thousand dollars, and shall deliver said bonds when so executed to the President of said Railroad Company or to his order, and the said Railroad Company shall at the
