

and completed its said line of railroad from the point in Johnson County aforesaid, in a westerly or southwesterly direction and through said Willow Springs Township and the line now running thereon, and shall have constructed a suitable freight and passenger depot in said Township as aforesaid, then the Board of County Commissioners of said Douglas County, for and in behalf of the said Willow Springs Township shall cause to be issued in the name and to the order of said Township of the denomination and on the terms and conditions hereinafter stated and described to the amount of Twenty five thousand dollars, and shall deliver said bonds when so executed to the President of said Railroad Company or to his order, and the said Railroad Company shall at the same time it receives said bonds make out, execute under seal of said Railroad Company, and deliver or tender to the Treasurer of said Willow Springs Township, in the name and for the benefit of said Township, certificates of full paid stock of the Capital stock of said Railroad Company, in an amount equal with the amount of the bonds of said Township, so received by it, dollar for dollar, in exchange therefor and in consideration thereof.

The ballots to be used at such special election, for and against the proposition to take stock and issue bonds therefor as above recited shall be in the following form, to wit:

The ballot in favor of said proposition, shall contain these words: "For the Railroad Stock and Bonds of the Kansas Colorado and Texas Railroad Company," and the ballot against said proposition shall contain these words: "Against the Railroad Stock and Bonds of the Kansas, Colorado and Texas Railroad Company."

And your petitioners will ever pray.

Now therefore, pursuant to the prayer of said petition and in compliance with the laws of the State of Kansas in such cases made and provided, and an act of the Legislature of the State of Kansas entitled, "An act to enable Counties, townships and Cities to aid in the construction of Railroads, and to repeal Section 8, of Chapter 39 of the Laws of 1874, which took effect February 29, 1876, and the acts of the Legislature of the State of Kansas amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, it is declared and ordered by the said Board of County Commissioners of said Douglas County, that the prayer of said petition be and the same is hereby granted; and that a special election be held in said Willow Springs Township, at the usual place of holding Elections therein on Tuesday the 29th day of June A.D. 1886, and that thirty days notice of said election be given by the Sheriff of said Douglas County as hereinafter provided, and that at said election the said proposition as set forth in said petition shall be submitted
