

Lawrence Kansas June 7. 1886.

The Board of County Commissioners met as a Board of Equalization at the Office of the County Clerk.

Those who present were Draper, John Matton and J. H. C. and County Clerk J. S. White.

The Board was in session daily (Sunday excepted) for two days considering individual assessments and on Thursday January 7, ordered the following changes to be made, to wit:

\$139⁰⁰ of A. H. J. 4 (as 4³⁴ RR) Sec. 7, S. 13 R. 21. returned by assessor at \$34.00, be changed to \$300.00 5³⁴ S. 4. S. 13 R. 21. changed from \$100.00 to \$60.00 (assessed to O. J. Richards)

\$6³⁴ S. 4. S. 12. 18. returned by the assessor at 74⁰⁰ be changed to \$640.00

The assessment Rolls of the following Townships were accepted by the Board and the several accounts as therein assessed agreed to.

Nauvoo, Grant, Recapture, Election, Marion, Willow Springs, Palmyra & Cedar. x It was further ordered that 8% be added to the returns of the assessor, on each piece or parcel of land in Nauvoo Township also that 8% be added to accounts returned by the assessor of the City of Lawrence, on all lots, pieces or parcels of land.

June 17th 1886, Board adjourned sine die.
