Agreement of Kansas, Colorado  
and Texas Railroad Company

It is hereby stipulated and agreed by the Kansas, Colorado  
and Texas Railroad Company, that if the proposition now pending in Palmyra Township  
in Douglas County, Kansas, to vote aid to and take stock in said Railroad Company,  
shall be decided at the election to be held in said township on the 29th day  
of June, A.D. 1886, in favor of said proposition, by a vote of the majority of the  
electors of said township, that then and in that event the said Railroad Company  
hereby agrees that it will locate a suitable freight and passenger depot building  
and stock yards, on the line of its railroad when built in said township,  
at or within one mile of the center of section number 7, in township 15.  
range 21 in said township, and that if it fails so to do, it agrees to  
forfeit the bonds allotted to it on the 29th day of June A.D. 1886, as  
aforesaid and it is further agreed, that these stipulations shall be  
filed with the County Clerk of said Douglas County, and become known  
by a part of said proposition as now pending in said township.
