The Board ordered, that in consideration of the withdrawal of the suit by the parties aforesaid, they be allowed in addition to the amount granted as damages at the Oct. Session 1885, as follows: to John J. Dobler two dollars \$2.00 to E. J. Martin twenty five dollars \$25.00 making a Total of \$27.00 to John J. Dobler and \$100.00 to E. J. Martin in full compensation for all damages occasioned by locating & establishing said road.
