

Order for Township
Subscription

Office of the County Clerk of Douglas County Kansas.
Lawrence Kansas. July, 10th 1886.

Now on this day the Board of County Commissioners of said County met in regular session, duly convened according to law, there being present Mr. Draper, Chairman of said Board, and John Walton and J. M. W., members of said Board and Joel S. White, County Clerk of said County, and said Board thereupon considered and examined the record of the Canvass by the County Clerk and the Board of County Commissioners, as a Board of Canvassers of the returns of the special election, held in Palmyra township in said County of Douglas on the 29th day of June 1886, submitting to the qualified electors of said township a proposition for said township to subscribe thirty five thousand dollars, to the Capital Stock of, and to take thirty five thousand dollars in the Capital Stock of the Kansas, Colorado and Texas Railroad Company, and issue the Bonds of said Palmyra township to the amount of thirty five thousand dollars, in payment for said Stock so taken, to the Kansas, Colorado and Texas Railroad Company, to aid in the construction of the line of Railroad which said Railroad Company proposes to construct from Kansas City in the State of Missouri into and through said Palmyra township, and the returns of said election as well, and after having duly examined and considered the said record of said Canvass and the returns of said election, said Board of County Commissioners find that there were cast in said Palmyra township, at said election, "For the Railroad Stock and Bonds of the Kansas, Colorado and Texas Railroad Company, Four hundred and twenty four (424) votes, and that there were cast in said Palmyra township at said special election "against the Railroad Stock and Bonds of the Kansas Colorado and Texas Railroad Company, Three hundred and nine (309) votes and said Board further finds that a majority of the whole number of qualified electors of said township voting at said election voted in favor of such railroad, Stock and Bonds, and in favor of the propositions therein set forth in the order of said Board of County Commissioners calling said special election.

It is therefore by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, in the State of Kansas, for and on behalf of said Palmyra township ordered that the County Clerk of said County make such subscription of Stock to the Capital Stock of the Kansas, Colorado and Texas Railroad Company, in the name of and for the benefit of said township to the amount of thirty five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) under the terms, conditions and restrictions, mentioned
