The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners Mr. Draper, Chairman, John Martin and J. E. McCoy and Jack S. White County Clerk.

The Board, having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the Establishment and Relocation of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered, that the Viewers Report and View and report and plat of Surveyor be adopted and the said road be declared relocated and established in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Freeborn Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk issue scrip payable to Samuel Baker for thirty dollars in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the relocation of said road. #482
