The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment
at the Office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioners H. Dwyer
Chairman, John Matton and J. E. McCoy, and County Clerk J. S. White.

In the Matter of the Road }

The Board of County Commissioners having
under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been
made against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of
public utility, it was ordered that the Survey report and view and report
and plat of the Survey be adopted and said road be declared located
and established, in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be
made in the "County Road Record," and the Trustee of Leominster Township
be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk issue scrip payable to
Jacob Strick for one hundred dollars and to Ann Roberts for two
dollars in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location
and establishment of said Road.
