Bids for excavating and masonry on the abutment of the Sutton bridge were opened, and Contract awarded to J. C. Pippert at 11¢ per foot. The abutments to be as follows.

East & West abutments 16 feet high, 20 feet long at bottom and 17 feet at top 5 feet wide at bottom and 3 feet at top, coping of top curves to be of stone at least two inches thick and to extend over wall on both sides and end six inches. The work to be done in a workmanlike manner in sand metal. Payment to be made when the work is completed and accepted by the board.
