The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners Wm. Draper, Chairman John Martin and J. Ed. Long, and County Clerk Joel S. White.

In the Matter of a Road
 Petitioned for by J. H. Williams & others

On the 1st day of October ad 1886 a road petition signed by J. H. Williams and 16 others was presented to Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the location of a certain road described as follows:

Beginning at the S.W. Corner of Sec. 37. T. 13. R. 18. E. Thence running west on or as near the section line as practicable to intersect the Lamonia and Emporia road near the S.W. Corner of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 31. T. 13. R. 18. E.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by Law, signed by J. H. Williams as principal and A. B. Hunt and H. M. Kenzie as sureties in the penal sum of all costs and expenses. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that J. R. Edson Esq. Thompson and Philip Simmons be appointed viewers of the proposed road and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day named in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
