The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the Office of the County Clerk.

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid Road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and finding it to be of public utility, it was ordered that the Viewers report and view and the report and plat of survey be adopted and the said road be defined located and established in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and the Justice of Willaco Springs Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

It was further ordered that the County Clerk be authorized to issue scrip to Rachel Watts for Fifty dollars and to Edward Jones for Forty dollars in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said roads # 435.
