Alex Shadley were awarded the contract for
and repairs on superstructure on the Sutton, Lebley & Ogden Bridges, according
to the terms, conditions and specifications contained in their bid of 11/11th inst.

We will furnish all material and
and complete the superstructure of bridges, the 40' feet long for \$225.00
Furnish Piece for frame, oak for joists and floor. The above includes all
frame and other work above the abutments. Shorter bridges same
proportion (to 36' feet) or we will do the framing and placing the
superstructure on the abutments for 50¢ County to furnish all team
work and material, shorter bridges same proportion \$1.00 per linear foot
to 36' feet long.
