Russell, Bauman & Co. at \$2.90 per ton for Scranton Shaft to County Poor Farm & Sylvania and \$3.00 per ton for Scranton Shaft delivered at jail and other County offices.

Also Shaw & Son were awarded the contract for ^{and repairs on} Superstructure on the Sutton, Sebley & Ogden Bridges, according to the terms, conditions and specifications contained in their bid of which, as follows:

Sir,

We will furnish all material (wood) and complete the Superstructure of Bridges, the 40 feet long for \$225.00. Furnish Piece for frame, oak for joist and floor. The above includes all frame and other work above the abutments. Shorter bridges same proportion (to 36 feet) or we will do the framing and replacing the Superstructure on the abutments for \$50.00. County to furnish all team work and material, Shorter bridges same proportion \$1.11 per linear foot to 36 feet long.

M. S. Melville was employed to repair the Mud Creek Bridge in Grant Sp. at a compensation for himself at \$5.00 per day and \$7.00 per day for his team.
