

And the said Board of County Commissioners, having carefully
 examined and duly considered said petition, and being fully
 advised in the premises, doth duly find that said petition
 is in due and legal form, and that said petition is in
 writing, and the same is duly signed by more than two-
 fifths of the resident tax payers of the said Township of Marion,
 in said Douglas County, and State of Kansas, and that said petition
 requests a special election to be called and ordered in said
 Marion Township, for the purpose of submitting to the duly qualified
 electors of said Marion Township, in said Douglas County, Kansas
 a proposition to subscribe to the capital stock of the Missouri
 Kansas and South Western Railway Company in and to the amount
 of fifteen thousand dollars, for and on behalf of said Marion
 Township, and to be paid for by the bonds of said Marion
 Township, and that the said petition contains the terms and
 conditions upon which it is proposed to make such subscription
 to the capital stock of said Railway Company and the form of the
 ballot to be used at such special election for and against
 such proposition. It is, therefore by the said Board of County
 Commissioners, of the said Douglas County, and State of Kansas
 hereby ordered and directed that a special election to be held in
 said the said Marion Township, in said County of Douglas, Kansas
 on the tenth day of May, AD 1857, at the usual place or places of
 voting in said Marion Township, in order that the duly qualified
 electors of said Marion Township may vote for and against the said
 proposition, to subscribe for and on behalf of said Marion Township,
 for fifteen thousand dollars of the capital stock, of the Missouri
 Kansas and South Western Railway Company, and issue the bonds
 of the said Marion Township to the amount of fifteen thousand dollars
 in payment of such subscription on the terms and conditions,
 contained in said petition, and it is further hereby ordered that
 the ballot to be used at such election for and against said
 proposition shall be in the form and contain the words stated
 and recited in said petition; and it is further hereby ordered
 that the said special election in said Marion Township shall be
 held and the returns made and the result thereof shall be
 ascertained and declared in the same way and manner as
 provided by law for general elections. And it is further, hereby
 ordered, that at least thirty days notice of said special election
 in said ^{Marion} Township shall be first duly given according to law,
 and that the notice of said election shall be published for at least
 thirty days next preceding the time of holding said election in
