Provided the said cause do not extend said time more than two years from the day on which said bonds are voted.

The form of the ballots to be used at said elections shall be "For the subscription of stock and issue of bonds to the Missouri Kansas and Southwestern Railway Company" and "Against the subscription of stock and issue of bonds to the Missouri Kansas and Southwestern Railway Company."

And the said Board of County Commissioners having carefully examined and duly considered said petition and being fully advised in the premises doth duly find that said petition is in ^{writing in} ~~the~~ legal form and that said petition is in writing and that the same is duly signed by two-fifths of the resident tax-payers of the said Township of Willow Springs in said Douglas County and State of Kansas, and that said petition requests a special election to be called and ordered in said Township of Willow Springs for the purpose of submitting to the duly qualified electors of said Willow Springs Township in said Douglas County Kansas a proposition to subscribe to the Capital Stock of the Missouri Kansas and Southwestern Railway Company in and to the amount of twelve thousand dollars for and on behalf of said Willow Springs Township to be paid for by the Bonds of said Willow Springs township and that the said petition contains the terms and conditions upon which it is proposed to make such subscription to the Capital Stock of said ^{special} Railway Company and the form of the ballots to be used at such ^{special} elections for and against such proposition.

It is therefore by the said Board of County Commissioners of the said Douglas County Kansas hereby ordered and directed that a special election be held in the said Township of Willow Springs in said Douglas County and State of Kansas on the tenth day of May A.D. 1887. at the usual place or places of voting in said Willow Springs Township in order that the duly qualified electors of said Willow Springs Township may vote for and against the said proposition to subscribe, for and on behalf of said Township of Willow Springs for twelve thousand dollars of the Capital Stock of the Missouri Kansas and Southwestern Railway Company, and issue the Bonds of the said Township of Willow Springs to the amount of twelve thousand dollars in payment of such subscription on the terms and conditions set forth and contained in said petition and it is further hereby ordered that the ballots to be used at such election for and against said proposition shall be in the form and contain the
