And it is further hereby ordered that the said Special Election in said Willow Springs Township, shall be held and the returns made and the result thereof shall be ascertained and declared in the same way and manner as provided by law for general elections.

And it is further hereby ordered that at least thirty days notice of said Special Election in said Willow Springs Township shall be first duly given according to law and that the notice of said Election shall be published for at least thirty days next preceding the time of holding said Election in said Willow Springs Township in the Lawrence Tribune a weekly newspaper published in said Douglas County Kansas, and of general circulation in said Willow Springs Township and in said Douglas County, and the Sheriff of said Douglas County and State of Kansas, be and he is hereby ordered and directed to give said notice and make due proclamation of said Special Election and the County Clerk of said Douglas County and State of Kansas is hereby ordered and directed to issue forthwith to the Sheriff of said Douglas County Kansas a duly certified copy hereof.
