

Lawrence Kansas April 11th AD 1887.

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk

There came present Commissioners John Muller, Chairman, J. C. McCoy, A. L. H. Draper and J. S. White County Clerk.

On the 7th day of March AD 1887 a road petition signed by H. F. Butler and 16 others, was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the location of a certain road, described as follows: "Beginning at the S.W. Corner of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 3, T. 15. R. 18. Thence East on Section line to the S.E. Corner of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 7, T. 15. R. 18. in Township 15 North, County and State aforesaid."

Said Petition, was accompanied with bond as required by law, signed by H. F. Butler as principal and J. R. Stuebner, Thomas Price, H. S. Custer & M. L. Oliver as sureties, in the penal sum of all costs and expenses accruing on the view, survey, and laying out of said road.

Whereupon, said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered, that David C. Halbert, S. A. Kilderman, David Robinson be appointed viewers of said road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the place of beginning in Union Township on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
