

Lancaster Mass. Saturday April 16, 1889.

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioners John Weston Chairman, J. E. McCarty, and W. D. Drake, and County Clerk J. S. White.

In the Matter of the  
Road petition of H. Little }

The aforesaid petition of H. Little, being under consideration, the following action thereon was had by said Board of County Commissioners, to wit:

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of that part of said road hereinafter mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility, it is Ordered, that the Viewer's report of view, and report and plat of survey be adopted - as follows: "Beginning at Railroad Crossing, on line, between Sec. 14 & 15, T. 13 N. R. 18. thence North on said line 15<sup>th</sup> chain to Section Corner" and that said part of the said Road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith; full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat as Road No. 438; and the Selectmen of Clinton Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel, 40 feet wide.

In the Matter of the  
Road petition of F. Derby }

The aforesaid petition of F. Derby, as recorded in Commission Record E. Page 474, being under consideration, the following action thereon was had by said Board of County Commissioners to wit:

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of that part of said road, hereinafter mentioned and described, and believing the same to be of public utility, it is Ordered, that the Viewer's report of view, and report and plat of survey be adopted - as follows: "Beginning at S. E. Cor. of Sec. 15, T. 13 N. R. 18. thence N. 1<sup>st</sup> ch. S. 25<sup>th</sup> N. 2<sup>nd</sup> ch. S. 14<sup>th</sup> N. 3<sup>rd</sup> ch. S. 70<sup>th</sup> N. 4<sup>th</sup> ch. S. 30<sup>th</sup> N. 1<sup>st</sup> ch. to a point 20 feet North of Section line. thence N. 18 ch. to a point 20 feet North of Sec. line and 20 feet South of the right of way of Lawrence & Superior R.R., thence along the right of way North 60<sup>th</sup> N. 4<sup>th</sup> ch." and that the said part of said Road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith; full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat as Road No. 439; and the Selectmen of Clinton Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel, 40 feet wide.

It is further ordered, that consent be issued to H. Little for Selectmen, for damages in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road.
