Treasury Commission.

The Board appointed M. J. Kennedy and Arthur S. Shepherd to assist the Probate Judge in receiving and counting the funds in the County Treasury.

The Board having under consideration the aforesaid petition and after a thorough discussion of the same and the personal testimony of Geo. J. Barker who was, at the time of the agreement, County Attorney and who now states that it was fully and distinctly understood at the time of the rendition of the judgment against said Mitchell, in the case of the State vs. Mitchell should not be or become a lien on the property of said Mitchell described in the petition filed herein. The following Resolution was passed.
