

Lawrence Mass. April 19, 1887.

In the Matter of a Road }
Petition by Eli J. Stinson. }

On the 3^d day of March 20th 1887, a Road Petition signed by Eli J. Stinson and 11 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, praying for the location of a certain road described as follows, to wit:

Beginning 20 R. 6 North of M. Cr. 7 S. 34 Sec. 29, 12, 20, at the Center of the Corner of East and Oak Streets in the City of Lawrence, thence East 160 rods, thence South 40 rods, thence East 160 rods, to the S.E. Cr. of S. 34 Sec. 28, T. 12, R. 20. Also Beginning at or near Riemers School house in School District No. 79, at the N.E. Corner of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 29, T. 12, R. 20, thence South 120 rods to the above described road.

Said Petition was accompanied with bond, as required by law, signed by Eli J. Stinson as principal and C. C. James and M. S. Smith as securities in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on the view.

Thereupon, said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered, that D. L. Woodley, W. A. Crumby and J. M. Adams, be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning in North Lawrence on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
