In the Matter of the Road }  
Petition of E. H. Slattery, Ltd }

The aforesaid petition recorded in Commissioners Record E. Page 600. being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners to wit:

Upon due consideration, no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road, and believing the same to be of public utility, it is ordered: That the Reviewer's report of view, and report and plat of survey be adopted, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith; full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat, as Road No. 1443 and the Director of Election Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel. 40 feet wide.

The Board having the aforesaid proposition under consideration it was ordered that E. H. Slattery be permitted to redeem lots 18, 20 & 22, Section 14, Baldwin City, for amount of original sale-endorsements, and costs of advertising and redemption.

Lease of rooms }

The Board signed Contract of lease for the rooms over Douglas County Ranch, for 5 years, ending January 1892, at the quarterly rental of \$15.00 payable, January, April, July, & October.
